

Isota Announces Single Spell Checker Solution for Real-Time, Cross-platform Applications in Windows

AccuSpell 2008 provides complete spell check solutions with customizable dictionaries. Consumers can now use only one spell check program for all their work in most popular windows applications.

Using cutting edge technology, AccuSpell lets users perform real-time spell checking, auto-corrections and thesaurus searches across most popular Windows applications. This allows a single spell checker and set of custom dictionaries to work for all applications on the user's PC, providing consistent, economical and comprehensive writing tools.

Using Windows "hooking" technology, AccuSpell 2008 scans text as it appears on the screen, and performs a spelling check. This provides for real-time spell checking regardless if the on-screen text is being entered from the keyboard, or displayed from an existing file, and errors are identified with Microsoft Word-style red underlining. Corrections are made from the spelling options incorporated into the application's menu, seamlessly integrating AccuSpell with the application.

AccuSpell 2008's capabilities include:

- . AccuSpell can be customized to recognize or ignore common Internet words, files and directories, repeated words, words in all upper case and more.
- . AccuSpell's enhanced search engine provides suggestions for misspelled words fast.
- . AccuSpell lets users choose to share existing Microsoft Word custom dictionaries with AccuSpell, or use AccuSpell's own custom dictionary. An Excluded-Word list is available for defining legal alternate spellings which the user wants to mark as incorrect, and Auto-Correct provides a list of words that are commonly misspelled. Users can edit the Auto-Correct dictionary to add automatic corrections for words they often type or spell incorrectly such as "the" for "teh."
- . AccuSpell searches automatically for updates and notifies users as soon as a new version is ready to download.
- . AccuSpell's comprehensive thesaurus is accessed from within the user's application and provides a list of synonyms, antonyms, related words and meanings, and the ability to instantly replace existing text with any of the search results.
- . Merriam-Webster's online dictionary is accessed through AccuSpell as an option on the user's right-mouse menu.
- . Isota offers 16 language dictionaries for its spell checking products. The dictionaries are available for download from the Isota Web site.

"AccuSpell 2008 is a leap forward in spell checking software," said Mark Geigel, president of Isota. "The user benefits are significant - before AccuSpell, users had to install different spell checkers for each application, and re-enter words in each program's custom dictionary. This resulted in extra work for the user, to say nothing of the inevitable inconsistencies between applications. With AccuSpell users can enjoy simple, universal spell checking."

AccuSpell is Isota's latest in its line of spell checking software. Future plans call for a AccuSpell include creating and sharing custom dictionaries over a network, as well as adding specialized dictionaries for specific markets, such as law and medicine.
