Jodi Cutler Del Dottore's motivation for writing was to create a strong hearing-impaired character who wears a cochlear implant. to provide a character in literature with whom her son and other deaf children could identify. Jodi, who lives in Grosseto, Italy, has taken RALLY CAPS a step further and is educating the Deaf community with her daily blog, "An American Mom in Tuscany: Jordan's Cochlear Implant Story."
