Spiritual Magazine Precognito Examines Likely Suspects In JonBenet Ramsey Case

READING, Mich./EWORLDWIRE/Jan. 20, 2009 --- "It is easier to join in the mass mob feeding frenzy than to put the best construction on all that we see and hear. It is easier to blame the masses than to look deeply into ourselves," says Rev. Robert Eickman Jr., Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, and Vacancy Pastor of Prince of Peace (Quincy, Michigan). Reverend Eickman is one of several spiritual contributors to Precognito Magazine's January 2009 cover story, which examines the twelve-year-old unsolved murder of six-year-old beauty queen JonBenet Ramsey.

"It's no surprise to us that our January cover story just happened to coincide with the re-opening of the JonBenet case," says Stempien.
