#3 “To search for a keyboard shortcut of a specific command, an editor simply enters the command name or topic. Touching it displays the details page with the command's shortcut and definition.

#4 “An editor can search by any FCP 7 Menu (such as File, Edit, View) and also by Groups (such as Audio, Marking, Importing).

#5 “When editors find commands they want to use in their next edit session, they simply tag the commands to add them to their Favorites list.

iKeysToGo: Final Cut Pro 7 is a must have reference and learning tool for any Final Cut Pro user. It's a great learning tool for teachers and students as well as professionals.
